There are 2 counsellors Louise Belcher and Julie Hyland.


Within the service we also run programmes that are designed to support students' sense of wellbeing and inclusiveness.

2025 RIS EOTC PROGRAMME

We are excited to share with our RIS whanau that we have been successful in securing funding from Tū Manawa and the CLM organisation, to support all students at Rosehill Intermediate School in 2025 to have the opportunity to experience authentic Education Outside The Class (EOTC) programmes. This funding will allow all of our students to attend a range of different EOTC learning activities free of cost. We are excited and grateful about this amazing opportunity we have for our students for 2025

The following EOTC programmes we will engage in during 2025 are outlined below:

Term 1: Year 7 Cohort: Vector Wero Water Park –

Students will have the opportunity to experience water safety and river crossing courses.

Term 1-4: Year 7 and Year 8 Cohort: Team Building Lessons –

This onsite experience led by classroom teachers will allow students to develop their team-building skills in their classes while working through a range of different physical activities during PE sessions.

Term 4: Year 7 and Year 8 Cohort: Tree Adventures –

Students will have the opportunity to experience 10 different courses of varying heights to support them in taking risks in a safe environment

Term 4: Year 8 Cohort: Sailing –

Students will have the opportunity to learn the foundational skills of sailing as well as water safety teaching them the importance of being safe in the water and making informed decisions in challenging situations


SCHOOL STATIONERY 2025
